Minutes of the meeting held on Thursday, 6th June 2019, at 7.30 pm in the Buccleuch Hall, Lindal.

46/19 Urgent business. Items normally needing to be publicised but received too late for the agenda. (Section 100B (4) (b) Local Government Act 1972)

47/19 Disclosure of interests. Requests for dispensations.

Councillor Mrs Glover declared an interest in agenda item 8 (c), a planning application regarding 10, The Green, Lindal, in that she was a near neighbour.

48/19 Minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on Thursday, 9th May 2019

The minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on Thursday, 9th May 2019, were taken as read and APPROVED.

49/19 Matters arising from those minutes.

1. 39/19 (a) Councillor Mrs Glover enquired as to the provision of a new pedestrian gate on the western side of Lindal village green. The Clerk reported that the gate had been ordered by Barrow Council and that a piece of railing would be provided as a temporary measure in the meantime.
2. 44/19 (b) Councillor Mrs Kelly asked whether the speed-gun was yet available for use in the Parish. The Clerk indicated that there had been further delays in arranging for it to be passed over to Lindal but that it was hoped for this to be completed over the coming weekend. At that stage, arrangements would be made to use the gun during the following couple of weeks.

50/19 Attendance of officer from Cumbria Constabulary

There was no officer in attendance and no crime details had been submitted. The Clerk would pursue the question of no attendance and no statistics.

51/19 Planning applications relating to the Parish

B21/2019/0424. extension, "Langdale", Pennington Lane, Lindal.

It was PROPOSED by Councillor Mrs Kelly and SECONDED by Councillor Lord that the Parish Council confirm that it had no objections to the application. Carried unanimously.

B21/2019/0426 extension to Chapel House, Pit Lane, Lindal.

It was PROPOSED by Councillor Lord and SECONDED by Councillor Mrs Glover that the Parish Council confirm that it had no objections to the application. Carried unanimously.

B23/2019/0425 Listed Building Consent, extension to 10 The Green Lindal.

The Clerk reminded members that a planning application in respect of this property had been considered by the Parish Council at its meeting in May when no objections had been raised to the proposed alterations. The current application was to take account of the building's Listed Building status insofar as the building works were concerned.

It was PROPOSED by Councillor Lord and SECONDED by Councillor Mrs Kelly that the Council confirm that, given the limited nature of the development, it had no objections to this proposal. Carried unanimously.

52/19 Correspondence.

- a) Planning applications relating to the whole of the Borough. The Clerk confirmed that the latest on-line list from Barrow Borough Council had been received and forwarded to Councillors. NOTED.
- b) Community Information and Safety. (including product recalls.)
 1. Fake emails. Malicious emails, supposedly from TalkTalk, were being circulated suggesting that customers were due for a refund. Such emails should be ignored.
 2. "Make Yourself Heard". The Police advise that when phoning them for help, and if it is impossible to give details, the caller, when prompted, should press 55. Doubts

were expressed as to how this would work in practice and Councillor Lord undertook to explore the matter further.

3. "Internet to be cut off..." Scam.

(all such notices are displayed on the Lindal notice board.)

53/19 Finance.
